DotW is a small but growing organization with increasing influence in the MdM International Network.

Doctors of the World values healthcare as a fundamental right and is committed to improving access to quality medical services for populations affected by systemic inequities including poverty, lack of access to healthcare, housing and education, conflict, or natural disasters. DotW provides services under all circumstances, regardless of gender, race, ethnicity, religion, age or political beliefs. DotW bears witness to health inequity worldwide. Globally, our network has deep expertise in five main program pillars: sexual and reproductive health and rights; migrants and refugee health; mental health; harm reduction; and disaster response.

About the Position

Doctors of the World USA has implemented a health-based migrant and refugee transitional care program at the southern US border with Mexico, in El Paso, Texas and Ciudad Juarez, Mexico. The program is focused on delivering services for the benefit of migrants and refugees on both sides of the border, and will leverage the considerable experience of the MdM International Network working with refugee populations throughout the world. We are working with an academic partner in El Paso and with local service providers. We launched an initial phase of the program at the end of 2022, and are now expanding the program in a second phase in 2023.

The program we have developed has six main cores (clinical services, education, data and research, advocacy, and international). For the purposes of this position, the data core is central to the program's impact, scalability and sustainability, and includes an electronic health record system. We are planning to implement an open-source data collection tool and electronic health record system developed by Hikma Health. The consultant's main objectives will be to customize, deploy, and manage the Hikma Health electronic health record system, and will work under the management and direction of program staff to continue to effectively deploy, maintain, and improve the system.

Technical Qualifications:

We are seeking a developer with strong devops skills who is comfortable deploying and maintaining applications with PostgreSQL databases.
